MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT  
(SPECIAL REMOVAL) ACT No. 16 OF 1982

To provide for the removal of Georges Cronsteadt and Guy Michel Prevot from Parliament.

WHEREAS Georges Cronsteadt and Guy Michel Prevot were elected members of the Representative Assembly on the 14th November 1979

AND WHEREAS on the 30th July 1980 they became members of Parliament by virtue of Article 87(1) of the Constitution

AND WHEREAS Guy Michel Prevot left Vanuatu on the 10th day of September 1980 and Georges Cronsteadt left Vanuatu on the 13th day of August 1980 pursuant to an order for his removal under section 17 of the Immigration Regulation No. 18 of 1971

AND WHEREAS both Georges Cronsteadt and Guy Michel Prevot were entitled to citizenship on application by virtue of Article 10 of the Constitution and the Citizenship (Entitled Persons) Regulation No. 13 of 1980

AND WHEREAS neither Georges Cronsteadt nor Guy Michel Prevot took advantage of Article 10 of the Constitution or the Citizenship (Entitled Persons) Regulation No. 13 of 1980 thus entitling them as of right to citizenship and to re-entry into Vanuatu

AND WHEREAS due to the absence from Vanuatu of Georges Cronsteadt and Guy Michel Prevot the electorate of the constituencies of Luganville and Port Vila have been, without representation in Parliament in respect of the seats of these members of Parliament

AND WHEREAS Parliament did on the 4th day of December 1981 declare the intention of Parliament to make the seats of Georges Cronsteadt and Guy Michel Prevot vacant

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the President and Parliament as follows :-
