SALE OF LIQUOR PROHIBITION FOR TAFEA, TONGOA/SHEPHERDS,
MALEKULA AND AMBAE/MAEWO LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCILS ELECTIONS
COMMENCING ON 30TH AUGUST 1989
ORDER No 30 OF 1989

For the good order and security for the TAFEA, TONGOA/SHEPHERDS, MALEKULA and AMBAE/MAEWO LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCILS ELECTIONS commencing on 30th August 1989, and;

IN EXERCISE of the power contained in section 8(2) of the Decentralisation Act No. 11 of 1980, the ELECTORAL COMMISSION HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

**SALE OF LIQUOR
PROHIBITED**

1. (1) All sale or supply of alcoholic liquor shall be prohibited at licensed premises (including clubs) within the Local Government Regions of TAFEA, TONGOA/SHEPHERDS, MALEKULA and AMBAE/MAEWO during the following period:

- From midnight on August 28th to midnight on August 30th, 1989.

- (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), alcoholic liquor may be sold during the prohibited period within the normal hours of opening in restaurants and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with their meals.

COMMENCEMENT

2. This Order shall come into force on the date thereof.
