THE LIQUOR LICENSING (PROHIBITION OF SALE)
ORDER No. 18 OF 1991

An order to prohibit the sale and supply of liquor in Santo/Malo, Pentecost and Efate Regions in the interest of public peace and good order during the Santo/Malo, Pentecost and Efate Local Government Council Elections.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Liquor Licensing Act [Cap. 52], I hereby make the following order:

SALE OF LIQUOR IN SANTO/MALO, PENTECOST AND EFATE REGIONS PROHIBITED

1. Subject to section 2, the sale and supply of alcoholic liquor at licensed premises within Santo/Malo, Pentecost and Efate Regions whether for consumption on or off the premises, is hereby prohibited from 7.30 a.m on Wednesday 21st day of August 1991 until midnight Thursday 22nd day of August 1991.

EXCEPTION

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1, alcoholic liquor may be sold during the said period within the normal hours of opening in restaurants and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with their meals.

COMMENCEMENT

3. This Order shall come into force on the 21st day of August, 1991.
