LIQUOR LICENSING ACT [CAP. 52]

LIQUOR LICENSING (PROHIBITION OF SALE)
ORDER NO 11 OF 1997

An order to prohibit the Sale and supply of liquor throughout the Island of Efate in the Republic of Vanuatu in the interest of the public, peace and good order during the Port Vila Municipal Council Elections.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Liquor Licensing Act [Cap 52], **I, ROBERT D KARIE**, Minister of Home Affairs and Decentralisation, hereby make the following Order:

SALE OF LIQUOR THROUGHOUT THE ISLAND OF EFATE.

1. Subject to subsection 2, the sale, supply and distribution of alcoholic Liquor at or on or from Stores and Licensed Premises throughout the Island of Efate in the Republic of Vanuatu whether for consumption on or off the premises is hereby prohibited from half-past seven o'clock in the morning (7.30 a.m) of Saturday 22 March 1997 until half past seven o'clock (7.30 a.m) in the morning of Tuesday 25 March 1997.

EXCEPTION

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 alcoholic liquor may be sold during the said period within the normal hours of opening in restaurants and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with their meals.

COMMENCEMENT

3. This Order shall come into force on Saturday the 22nd day of March, 1997.
