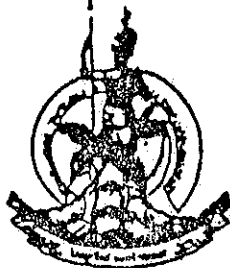

(APPOINTED DAY) ORDER No. 7 OF 1987

An Order to fix the "appointed day" for the purposes of the Revised Edition of the Laws of Vanuatu.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Revision and Consolidation of the Laws Act No. 25 of 1985, I hereby make the following Order:-

APPOINTED DAY

1. The revision date for the Revised Edition of the Laws of Vanuatu known as the "appointed day" shall be the first day of May, 1987.

COMMENCEMENT

2. This Order shall come into force on the day of its publication in the Gazette.

THE IMPORT CONTROL ORDER NO. 8 OF 1987

To control the import of frozen chickens, frozen chicken pieces and eggs.

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 2 of the Import of Goods (Control) Act No. 19 of 1984 and section 15 of the Interpretation Act No. 9 of 1981, I hereby make the following Order :-

REVOCATIONS AND LICENCES RELATING TO CERTAIN GOODS

1. (a) Orders No. 12 of 1983 and No. 31 of 1985 are hereby revoked.
- (b) No Frozen chickens, frozen chicken pieces or poultry eggs in shell shall be imported into the Republic of Vanuatu except by a person holding an import licence issued by the Minister of Finance under this Order.

COMMENCEMENT

2. This Order shall come into operation on the date of publication in the Official Gazette.
