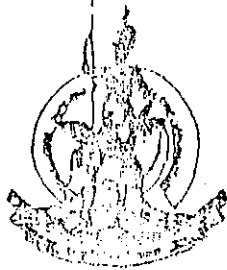

LAND REFORM (AMENDMENT) ACT NO. 6 OF 1992

An Act to amend the Land Reform Act [CAP 123].

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Parliament as follows:-

AMENDMENT OF SECTION 9 OF CHAPTER 123

1. Section 9 of the Land Reform Act [CAP 123] in this Act referred to as the principal Act is amended by repealing subsection (1) and substituting the following subsection:-

"(1) On the day of Independence all state land shall vest in the Government and be public land and be held by it for the benefit of the Republic of Vanuatu."

REPEAL OF SECTIONS 10, 11, 12 and 13 OF THE PRINCIPAL ACT

2. Sections 10, 11, 12 and 13 of the principal Act are hereby repealed.

EFFECT OF REPEAL OF SECTIONS 10, 11, 12 AND 13 OF THE PRINCIPAL ACT

3. The repeal of sections 10, 11, 12 and 13 of the principal Act shall not affect -
 - (a) any declaration, order, or rule made, certificate authority or permit granted, registration effected or other thing done; or
 - (b) any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred

under those sections.

COMMENCEMENT

4. This Act shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Gazette.

LOI N° 6 DE 1992 SUR LA REFORME FONCIERE
(MODIFICATION)

Portant modification de la Loi sur la Réforme foncière (CAP.123)*.

Le Président de la République et le Parlement promulguent le texte suivant :

MODIFICATION DE L'ARTICLE 9 DU CHAPITRE 123

1. Modifier l'article 9 de la Loi sur la Réforme foncière (CAP.123), ci-après nommée la Loi principale, en supprimant le paragraphe 1), remplacé par le nouveau paragraphe suivant :

"1) Au jour de l'Indépendance, toutes les terres de l'Etat deviennent propriété de la République, sont déclarées terres domaniales et sont détenues par l'Etat dans l'intérêt de la République de Vanuatu."

ABROGATION DES ARTICLES 10, 11, 12 ET 13 DE LA LOI PRINCIPALE

2. Sont abrogés par les présentes les articles 10, 11, 12 et 13 de la Loi principale.

CONSEQUENCES DE L'ABROGATION DES ARTICLES 10, 11, 12 ET 13

3. L'abrogation des articles 10, 11, 12 et 13 de la Loi principale n'ont aucun effet :

a) sur toute déclaration, arrêté ou décision rendue, certificat, autorisation ou permis délivré, enregistrement effectué ou autre acte accompli : ni

b) sur tout droit, privilège, obligation ou charge acquis, obtenus ou assumés

en application des dispositions desdits articles.

ENTREE EN VIGUEUR

4. Le présent texte entrera en vigueur à la date de sa publication au Journal officiel.

CHAPTER 52

THE LIQUOR LICENSING (CLOSURE OF LICENSED PREMISES) ORDER NO. 17 1992

An Order to close the licensed premises known as "The Seven Stars Club",
Luganville Santo.

IN EXERCISE of the power conferred by Section 22(2) of the Liquor
Licensing Act [CAP. 52], I hereby make the following Order:-

CLOSURE OF THE SEVEN STARS CLUB AT LUGANVILLE, SANTO

1. In accordance with Section 22(2) of the Liquor Licensing Act
[CAP. 52], the licensed premises known as the "Seven Stars Club"
at Luganville, Santo is hereby ordered to be closed down in the
interest of peace and good order for an indefinite period.

COMMENCEMENT

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force as from
6.00 p.m on Friday 23rd October, 1992.

HEALTH PRACTITIONERS ACT [CAP. 164]

TERMINATION OF APPOINTMENT

WHEREAS in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 2(1)(b) of the Health Practitioners Act [CAP. 164] the Minister of Health shall appoint five members to the Health Practitioners Board.

AND WHEREAS Section 2(2) of [CAP. 164] provides that such appointments shall be for a term of 3 years.

AND WHEREAS DOAN BA TRI a contract officer within the Government of the Republic of Vanuatu was appointed to the Health Practitioners Board with effect from February 14, 1992 to represent surgery for a term of three years.

AND WHEREAS the said DOAN BA TRI's contract with the Government of the Republic of Vanuatu has expired and the said DOAN BA TRI has permanently left Vanuatu on November 4, 1992.

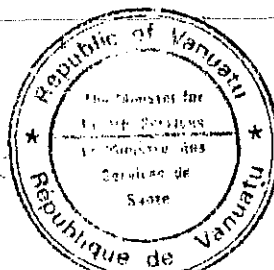
AND WHEREAS BY leaving Vanuatu permanently, the said DOAN BA TRI has left a vacancy in the Health Practitioners Board with effect from November 4, 1992.

THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 2(2) of the Health Practitioners Act [CAP.164] I, HILDA LINI, Minister of Health and Rural Water Supply hereby terminate the appointment of DOAN BA TRI to the Health Practitioners Board with effect from November 4, 1992.

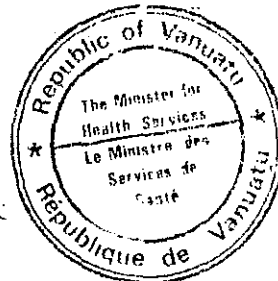
