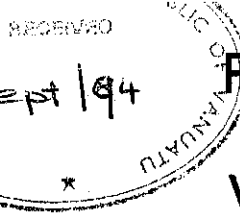

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 32(3) of the Decentralization and Local Government Regions Act No. 1 of 1994, I, MAXIME CARLOT KORMAN, Prime Minister and Minister of Public Service, Planning and Statistics, Media Services and Language Services, make the following Order:-

DISSOLUTION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCILS

1. The Local Government Councils established under the Decentralization Act [Cap. 127] specified in the Schedule are hereby dissolved.

REPEAL OF CERTAIN ORDERS

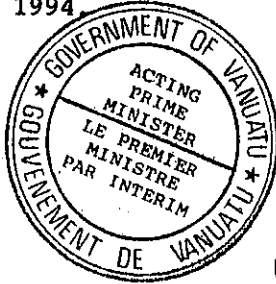

- (i) Decentralization (Efate Local Government Region) Order No. 35 of 1983;
- (j) Decentralization (Pentecost Local Government Region) Order No. 36 of 1983;
- (k) Decentralization (Santo/Malo Local Government Region) Order No. 37 of 1983.

**COMMENCEMENT**

Local Government Councils (Establishment) Order No.26 of 1994

To establish local government councils for local government regions established under the Decentralization And Local Government Regions Act No. 1 of 1994.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 4, I, MAXIME CARLOT KORMAN, Prime Minister and Minister of Public Service, Planning and Statistics, Media Services and Language Services, make the following Order:

**DEFINITIONS**

1. In this Order -

"Act" means the Decentralization and Local Government Regions Act No. 1 of 1994;

"MALAMPA region" means the MALAMPA local government region declared under section 3(1) of the Act;

"PENAMA region" means the PENAMA local government region declared under section 3(1) of the Act;

"SANMA region" means the SANMA local government region declared under section 3(1) of the Act;

"SHEFA region" means the SHEFA local government region declared under section 3(1) of the Act;

"TAFEA region" means the TAFEA local government region declared under section 3(1) of the Act;

"TORBA region" means the TORBA local government region declared under section 3(1) of the Act.

**TAFEA LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL**

2. A local government council to be known as the TAFEA Local Government Council is hereby established for the TAFEA region.

**SHEFA LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL**

3. A local government council to be known as the SHEFA Local Government Council is hereby established for the SHEFA region.

**MALAMPA LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL**

4. A local government council to be known as the MALAMPA Local Government Council is hereby established for the MALAMPA region.

**PENAMA LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL**

5. A local government council to be known as the PENAMA Local Government Council is hereby established for the PENAMA region.

**SANMA LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL**

6. A local government council to be known as the SANMA Local Government Council is hereby established for the SANMA region.


**TORBA LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCIL**

7. A local government council to be known as the TORBA Local Government Council is hereby established for the TORBA region.

**COMMENCEMENT**

8. This Order shall come into force on the 15th day of September, 1994.

ACT NO. 1 OF 1994

LOCAL GOVERNMENT COUNCILS (DATE OF ELECTIONS)  
ORDER NO. 27 OF 1994

To declare the date for the start of elections for councillors to the Local Government Councils established under the Local Government Councils (Establishment) Order No. 26 of 1994;

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 32(4) of the Decentralization and Local Government Regions Act No. 1 of 1994, and rule 1 of the Local Government Council Election Rules Order No. 61 of 1982, as amended, the ELECTORAL COMMISSION hereby makes the following order:-

**DATE OF ELECTION**

1. The election for councillors to the -

- (a) TAFEA Local Government Council;
- (b) SHEFA Local Government Council;
- (c) MALAMPA Local Government Council;
- (d) PENAMA Local Government Council;
- (e) SANMA Local Government Council;
- (f) TORBA Local Government Council,

shall commence on the 15th day of November, 1994.

**RETURN OF LIST AND CANDIDATURE**

2. (1) A party wishing to contest any or all of the local government council elections referred to in section 1 must submit its list and declarations of candidature in respect of every candidate on its list from the date of the commencement of this Order until not later than 4.30 p.m. on Friday the 14th day of October, 1994 to the Principal Electoral Officer in Vila or to the Secretary of any of the dissolved eleven local government councils.

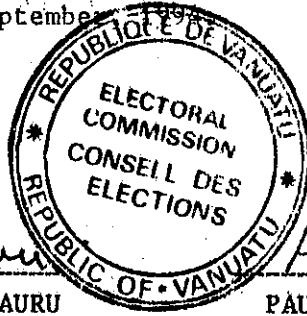
(2) In this section -

- (a) "list" has the same meaning assigned to it in rule 1 of the Local Government Council Elections Rules Order No. 61 of 1982;

- (b) "dissolved eleven Local Government Councils" means the local government councils dissolved by the Local Government Councils (Dissolution) Order No. 25 of 1994; and
- (c) "party" has the meaning assigned to it in rule 1 of the Local Government Council Elections Rules Order No. 61 of 1982.

**COMMENCEMENT**

3. This Order shall come into force on the 15th day of September 1994.
