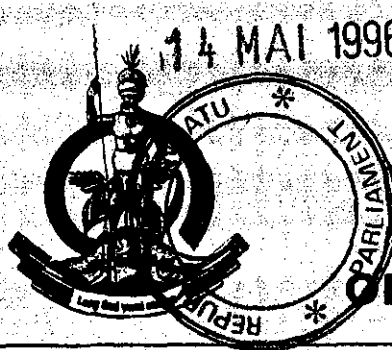

CHAPTER 168

OFFICIAL SALARIES ORDER NO. 7 OF 1996

To amend the Schedule to the Official Salaries Act [CAP. 168].

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by section 3 of the Official Salaries Act [CAP. 168], I, MAXIME CARLOT KORMAN, Prime Minister and Minister of Public Service, Planning and Statistics and Language Services, with prior approval of the Council of Ministers, hereby make the following Order -

AMENDMENT OF PART 1 OF THE SCHEDULE TO CHAPTER 168

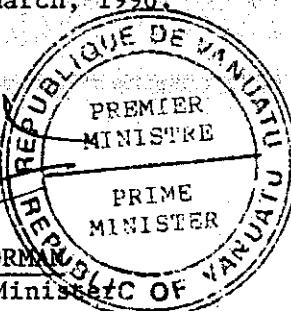
1. Part 1 of the Schedule to the Official Salaries Act [CAP. 168] is amended as follows -

- (a) In column 1 by deleting the item "Ministers' Secretary/Typists" and substituting the item "Ministers' Secretary-Typists Grade 1".
- (b) In column 2 by adding immediately after the figure "809,496" corresponding to the item "Council of Ministers Office Supervisor" the figure "720,000" corresponding to the item "Ministers' Secretary-Typists Grade 1".
- (c) In column 3 by adding the item "D+E+G+I+J" corresponding to "Ministers' Secretary-Typists Grade 1".
- (d) In column 1 by adding immediately after the item "Ministers' Secretary-Typists Grade 1" the item "Ministers' Secretary-Typists Grade 2".
- (e) In column 2 by adding the figure "590,712" corresponding to the item "Ministers' Secretary-Typists Grade 2".
- (f) In column 3 by adding the item "D+E+G+I+J" corresponding to the item "Ministers' Secretary-Typists Grade 2".

COMMENCEMENT

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of March 1996.

COMMUTATION OF SENTENCE


WHEREAS Article 38 of the Constitution provide inter alia, for the President of the Republic to commute a sentence imposed on a person convicted of an offence.

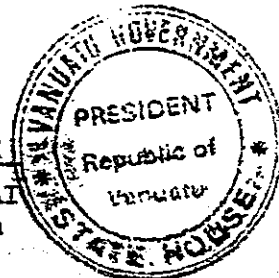
AND WHEREAS FREDDY WASS of Santo was on 1st November 1994 convicted of Unlawful entry and theft and sentenced to imprisonment for a term of one year.

NOW THEREFORE in the exercise of the powers conferred on me by Article 38 of the Constitution, I, JEAN MARIE LEYE LENALCAU MANATAWAI, President of the Republic of Vanuatu hereby order: -

1. That FREDDY WASS be set free and released from prison as of 5th day of April, 1996 SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS set out as follows:
 - a) That the remaining sentence of imprisonment imposed on FREDDY WASS be suspended as of 5th day April 1996.
 - b) That FREDDY WASS shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour for a period commencing on the day of release being 5th day of April 1996 ending on 4th November 1996, this period shall hereinafter be called the relevant period.
 - c) In the event that FREDDY WASS should commit a criminal offence during the relevant period the original sentence shall be immediately executed and FREDDY WASS shall be recalled and returned to prison and shall serve the remaining sentence he would have served if his imprisonment sentence had not been suspended as of 5th day of April, 1996.

CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC

COMMUTATION OF SENTENCE


WHEREAS Article 38 of the Constitution provide inter alia, for the President of the Republic to commute a sentence imposed on a person convicted of an offence.

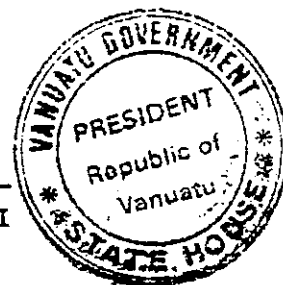
AND WHEREAS KENDA LELE of Malo was on 2nd September 1994 convicted of intentional homicide entry and theft and sentenced to imprisonment for a term of ten years.

NOW THEREFORE in the exercise of the powers conferred on me by Article 38 of the Constitution, I, JEAN MARIE LEYE LENALCAU MANATAWAI, President of the Republic of Vanuatu hereby order: -

1. That KENDA LELE be set free and released from prison as of 5th day of April, 1996 SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS set out as follows:
 - a) That the remaining sentence of imprisonment imposed on KENDA LELE be suspended as of 5th day April 1996.
 - b) That KENDA LELE shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour for a period commencing on the day of release being 5th day of April 1996 ending on 21st day of September 2002, this period shall hereinafter be called the relevant period.
 - c) In the event that KENDA LELE should commit a criminal offence during the relevant period the original sentence shall be immediately executed and KENDA LELE shall be recalled and returned to prison and shall serve the remaining sentence he would have served if his imprisonment sentence had not been suspended as of 5th day of April, 1996.


THE COMPANIES ACT [CAP 191]
