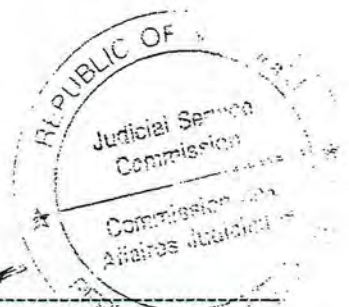
**COMMISSION OF INQUIRY ORDER NO. 33 OF 1999**

A further Order to issue a Commission of Inquiry to inquire into the causes and circumstances that led to the crash of the Vanair Flight No. 503 on 8<sup>th</sup> May, 1999 and the loss of the MV Latua on or about 8 May, 1999 and to make appropriate recommendations:

**IN EXERCISE** of the powers conferred upon me by section 1(1) and (2) of the Commission of Inquiry Act [CAP. 85], I, **DONALD KALPOKAS**, Prime Minister of Vanuatu and Minister responsible, by this Order issue the following commission:-

The Commissioner shall make a report of the proceedings and of the result of his inquiry to the Prime Minister, as the Minister of Justice not later than 31 August 1999.




