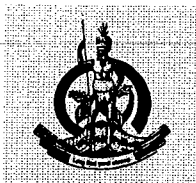

Animal Importation and Quarantine (Amendment) Regulation

Order No. 44 of 2002

To amend the Animal Importation and Quarantine Regulation Order No. 14 of 1994

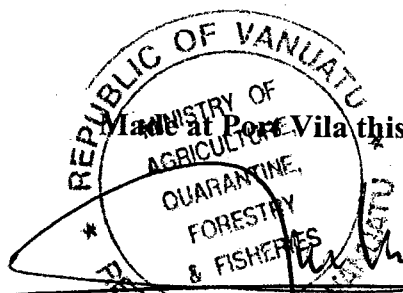
In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 22 of the Animal Importation and Quarantine Act [Cap 201], I, Steven Kalsakau, Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries make the following Regulation.

1 Amendments

The Animal Importation and Quarantine Act [Cap 201] is amended as set out in the Schedule.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on ^{11th} Sept., 2002

SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS OF THE ANIMAL IMPORTATION AND QUARANTINE ACT [CAP 201]

1 Paragraph 28 (b)

Repeal paragraph 28 (b), substitute

“(b) have not been vaccinated, and their parents have not been vaccinated, against Newcastle disease or fowl plague using a modified live virus vaccine;

(ba) either:

- (i) come from hatcheries situated in a state or territory of Australia free from Newcastle disease and fowl plague; or
- (ii) come from hatcheries situated in a country other than Australia free from Newcastle disease and fowl plague;”.

2 Paragraph 29 (a)

Repeal paragraph 29 (a), substitute

“(a) either:

- (i) come from establishments or hatcheries situated in a state or territory of Australia free from Newcastle disease and fowl plague; or
- (ii) come from establishments or hatcheries situated in a country other than Australia free from Newcastle disease and fowl plague;”.

3 Paragraph 36 (a)

Repeal 36 (a) substitute

“(a) either:

- (i) which have been kept in an establishment situated in a state or territory of Australia free from Newcastle disease and fowl plague; or
- (ii) which have been kept in an establishment situated in a country other than Australia free from Newcastle disease and fowl plague;”.

POLICE ACT CAP [105]


I, the Honourable Nipake E.Natapei Tuta Fanuaa'ariki, Prime Minister of the Republic of Vanuatu, consider that there is a grave threat to the internal security of Vanuatu and in accordance with section 5 of the Police Act [CAP 105] direct that:

- (a) police officers whose names are annexed herein are to be employed as a special internal security force for Vanuatu
- (b) Major Joshua Bong is to command the special internal security force and must select the members and officers of the special internal security force;
- (c) Captain Selwyn Olul is to be the Deputy Commander of operations of the special internal security force;
- (d) Major Author Caulton is to be co-ordinator of operations and the representative of the Government on the special internal security force;
- (e) the special internal security force must comply with the orders of the Prime Minister;
- (f) the special internal security force must:
 - (i) Apprehend immediately those persons involved in the arrest and detention of senior government officials and other persons on Sunday 4th August 2002 which actions amount to offences under the Penal Code Act [CAP 135] and the Police Act [105]; and
 - (ii) ensure immediately that the Vanuatu Police Force returns to its normal duties and functions; and
 - (iii) ensure the security of the President of the Republic of Vanuatu and other senior officials of the Government; and

- (iv) ensure the security of the property of the Government and other essential services and facilities

This Direction comes into force on the day on which it is made and remains in force for a period of 14 days from that date.

POLICE ACT CAP [105]


I, the Honourable Nipake E Natapei Tuta Fanuaa'ariki, Prime Minister of the Republic of Vanuatu, having issued a direction under section 5 of the Police Act [CAP 105] on 26th August 2002 which remained in force until 8 September 2002, consider that there is still a grave threat to the internal security of Vanuatu and in accordance with section 5 of the Police Act [CAP 105] direct that:

- (a) police officers whose names are annexed hereto are to continue to be employed as a special internal security force for Vanuatu; and
- (b) Major Joshua Bong is to continue to command the internal security force and continues to have the power to select the officers of the special internal security force; and
- (c) Captain Selwyn Olul is to continue to be the Deputy Commander of operations of the special internal security force; and
- (d) Major Arthur Caulton is to continue to be the co-ordinator of operations of the special internal security force and the representative of the Government on the special internal security force; and
- (f) the internal security force must comply with the orders of the Prime Minister; and
- (g) the internal security force must:
 - (i) apprehend immediately any persons who have not previously been apprehended and who were involved in the arrest and detention of senior government officials and other persons on Sunday 4th August 2002 which actions may constitute offences under the Penal Code Act [CAP 135] and the Police Act [CAP 135]; and
 - (ii) ensure that the Vanuatu Police Force returns to its normal duties and functions; and
 - (iii) ensure the security of the President of the Republic of Vanuatu and senior officials of the Government; and

- (iv) ensure the security of the property of the Government and other essential services and facilities.

This Direction is deemed to have come into force on the 9th day of September 2002 and remains in force until 5th October 2002.
