AN ACT to authorise the issue and application of certain sums of money out of the Treasury Fund, the Western Samoa Treasury Banana Scheme Account and the Samoan Public Trustee's Account to the services of the year ending with the thirty-first day of December 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the year 1974) and to appropriate those sums of money to those services; and to authorise the issue and application of certain additional sums of money out of the Treasury Fund to the services of the year which ended on the thirty-first day of December 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the year 1972) and to appropriate those sums of money to those services. [11 January 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:—

1. Short title and application—(1) This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1973.

(2) Sections 2, 3 and 4 of this Act relate to the year 1974.

(3) Section 5 of this Act relates to the year 1972.

2. Grant and appropriation of \$11,785,196 out of the Treasury Fund—(1) There may be issued out of the Treasury Fund and applied to the services of the year 1974 any sums

which do not exceed in the aggregate the sum of eleven million seven hundred and eighty-five thousand and one hundred and ninety-six tālā.

(2) The sums authorised to be applied by subsection (1) of this section are hereby appropriated to the services expressed in the several votes specified in the First Schedule to this Act.

3. Grant and appropriation of \$1,271,930 out of the Western Samoa Treasury Banana Scheme Account—(1) There may be issued out of the Western Samoa Treasury Banana Scheme Account in the Bank of Western Samoa and applied to the services of the year 1974 any sum which does not exceed the sum of one million two hundred and seventy-one thousand and nine hundred and thirty tālā.

(2) The sum authorised to be applied by subsection (1) of this section is hereby appropriated to the services of the Produce Marketing Division of the Department of Agriculture.

4. Grant and appropriation of \$21,731 out of the Samoan Public Trustee's Account—(1) There may be issued out of the Samoan Public Trustee's Account in the Bank of Western Samoa and applied to the services of the year 1974 any sum which does not exceed the sum of twenty-one thousand seven hundred and thirty-one tālā.

(2) The sum authorised to be applied by subsection (1) of this section is hereby appropriated to the services of the Samoan Public Trust Office.

5. Grant and appropriation of \$157,305 out of the Treasury Fund—(1) Sanction is hereby granted to the issue out of the Treasury Fund and application to the services of the year 1972 of sums totalling one hundred and fifty-seven thousand three hundred and five tālā in addition to the sums which have been appropriated for the year 1972 under the Appropriation Act 1971 and the Supplementary Appropriation Act 1972.

(2) Sanction is hereby granted to the appropriation to the services expressed in the several votes specified in the Second Schedule to this Act of the sum authorised to be applied by subsection (1) of this section.

6. Authority to write off losses of public money and public stores amounting to \$11,298.61—Whereas the losses of public money and public stores specified in the Third Schedule to this Act have occurred, amounting in the whole to eleven thousand two hundred and ninety-eight tālā and sixty-one sene BE IT ENACTED as follows:—

(1) The amount specified in the Third Schedule, being sums of public money and the value of public stores, hereby written-off.

(2) No person, other than an accounting officer within the meaning of the Public Moneys Act 1964, shall be deemed to be discharged, by reason only of the fact that the said amounts are written-off, from any liability in respect of any public money or public stores to which this section applies.
