Title 1 Short title 2. Repeal

AN ACT to amend the Reprint of Statutes Act 1972.

[27 August 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:—

- Short title—This Act may be cited as the Reprint of Statutes Amendment Act 1974, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Reprint of Statutes Act 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 2. Repeal—The principal Act is hereby amended, as from its commencement, by repealing section 8, and substituting the following new section:
- "8. Statutes repealed—(1) Subject to section 7 of this Act, all enactments and laws whatsoever in force in Western Samoa at the commencement of the Samoa Constitution Order 1920 (New Zealand), in so far as they may be still in force at the commencement of this Act, are hereby repealed.
- (2) All United Kingdom or New Zealand statutes heretofore in force in Western Samoa, other than those specified in the Schedule hereto, shall cease to be part of the law of Western Samoa on the coming into force of this Act.

(3) This section shall not affect any document made or anything done heretofore under the authority of any such enactments, laws or statutes and subsisting or in force at the date of commencement of this Act."
